of Kirkheaton and county aforesaid in one hundred pounds of Lawfull money of Great Britain to be
paid to the said Edward Dyson and Abel Stringer or to their certain Attourney Executors Administrators
or Assignes. To which payment well and truly to be maid we bind ourselves and our Successors for
the time being for the whole and in the whole Jointly and Severally Firmly by these Presents sealed
with our seals Dated the Twenty Third day of August one Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty.

Whereas Mary Kaye of Kirkheaton aforesaid Singlewoman is now big and pregnant with a Bastard
Child which when born will become Chargeable to the said Township pf Dalton. Now the Condition of this
Obligation is such that if the above bound Richard Morton and John Senior either of them or their successors
do and shall from time to time and at all times, hereafter, fully and clearly acquit free and discharge, or well
and sufficiently save and keep harmless and indemnified the above named Edward Dyson and Abel Stringer
Churchwardens and overseers of the poor of Dalton aforesaid and their successors, as also the Inhabitants and
Parishioners of the said Township of Dalton and every of them of and from all manner of Expences Damages Costs
and charges whatsoever which shall or may at any time hereafter arise happen grow or be imposed upon them
or either or any of them for or by reason of or means of the said Mary Kayes being great with Child as aforesaid or
for or by reason of the Birth maintainte Education and bringing up of such Child or Children that she the said
Mary Kaye now goeth with and shall be delivered of, and of and from all other Actions Suits troubles Charges
Damages and Demands Whatsoever touching or concerning the same, then this Obligation to be void, otherwise
To be and remain in full force and virtue.
